## IN FLANDERS FIELDS MUSEUM

Cloth Hall, Grote Markt 34, 8900 Ypres

The In Flanders Fields Museum confronts the visitor with both past and present, with war and with the hope of peace. The story of a Great War narrated by thousands of Ordinary People is merged together. A visit to the IFFM is an enthralling and entertaining experience that gives you food for thought.

## MUNICIPAL MUSEUM OF EDUCATION

G. de Stuersstraat 6 a, 8900 Ypres

Tuesday through Sunday from 10 a.m. to 12 noon and from 1.30 p.m. to 5 p.m. Closed on Mondays. Closed on 25/12.

This museum is established in the former church of St Nicholas, which is unique in Flanders. The Museum of Education shows the history of education in Flanders from the middle ages to the present day.

## MUNICIPAL MUSEUM

Ieperleestraat 31, 8900 Ypres

Tuesday through Sunday from 10 a.m. to 12 noon and from 1.30 p.m. to 5 p.m. Closed on Mondays. Closed on 25/12.

This museum is located in the former Sint-Jansgodshuis (Saint John's almhouse). The building from 1555 is one of the rare buildings in Ypres not to have been entirely destroyed during WWI. The Municipal Museum narrates the centuries old history of the city by means of paintings, pictures, maps and original photos. There is also an overview of fine and applied arts as from the 16th century: paintings, sculptures, graphics as well as tin, silver and ironwork. The jewel in the crown is the extensive collection of the works by Ypres artist Louise De Hem.

## 'AROUND YPRES' WALKING MAP

The city of Ypres has a great deal to offer its visitors. This walking map comprises 4 routes: the ramparts route, the green outskirts, the northern city outskirts with the rampart ruins and the historic inner city. They all fit in closely with one another and are therefore easy to combine. The main sites and monuments are indicated on each route: 101 enthralling spots that require a short explanation.

## 'THE NIGHT WATCH' EVENING WALK

Start: The Menin Gate on Saturday evening (NL/EN guide) from 5.30 p.m. to 7.30 p.m. (minimum 6 participants)

The night watch will be expecting you with halberd and flaming torch at 5.30 p.m. at the Menin Gate; he will lead you into the darkness of mediaeval Ypres. The guide will highlight some familiar and unfamiliar mediaeval corners of Ypres.
